What are Achievement Logs given for?

 Caldew School Rewards 		
At Caldew School we understand the importance of rewarding and celebrating students. Below is a chart which sets out the school's Reward System.		
Daily	Classroom Achievement Log (1 Point) In every lesson you can earn an achievement log. This could be for having a good attitude to learning, quality work, excellent effort or improved progress.	Achievement points will be logged on Sims by your teacher.
Weekly	HOY Star of the Week (5 Points) Students with the highest number of achievement points during the week will achieve this reward.	A certificate will be given out in assembly
Weekly	Caldew Communiy Achievement Logs (2 Points) Extra curricular participation (Sport/P Arts/Student Council/Maths Challenge/Workshops/Good Attitude and behaviour on school trips.	Achievement points will be logged on Sims – please make sure you register for the different activities!
Half Termly	Achievement Certificates These are based on acievement points accrued Bronze - 75 Silver - 150 Gold - 300 Platinum - 600 1200+ Club.	A certificate will be given out in assembly each half term
Half Termly	Department Star of the Half Term - 1 Per Year Group (5 Points) Awarded for the highest number of achievements in a particluar subject.	A certificate will be given out by the Head of Department.
Half Termly	Headteacher Star of the Half Term - 1 Per Year Group (5 Points) Nominated by the Head of Year.	Breakfast with the Headteacher and a text will be sent home.
Termly	Rewards Event The top 50 students in each year group are invited.	There are different events which can take place in and out of school.
Yearly	Caldew Annual Awards Ceremony Stars of the year nominated for work in subjects, highest number of achievements, outstanding contribution to Caldew Community.	Parents invited to an awards presentation ceremony.

What are Behaviour Logs given for?

Inside the Classroom Behaviour Ladder

At Caldew School we expect students to behave responsibly and follow instructions from staff. Below is a chart which sets out the school's behaviour curriculum.

C6	Very serious incident - immediate removal from the lesson Refocus or Suspension.	Examples Include: Swearing at staff, child on child abuse, bullying, fighting, assault, harassment.
C5	Class Visits called and removal from the lesson. Behaviour log - Senior Leader Detention (40 minute). Parents informed.	Examples Include: Sustained defiance, failure to respond to C4, a one-serious incident. Missed Middle Leader Detention
C4	Class visit called - Student spoken to by class visits. Behaviour log - Middle Leader Detention (20 minute). Parents informed.	Examples Include: Repeated defiance, a one-off incident such as leaving the classroom without permission, using inappropriate language. Missed Class Detention.
C3	Continues behaviour after C1 and C2 warning. Behaviour log -10 minute teacher detention at break or lunch.	Examples of behaviours for a C1,2,3 Include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Speaking when asked not to Not completing work Answering back Not following instructions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Head on desk Out of seat without permission <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Making silly noises Making faces/body gestures Mobile phone, earbuds or headphones issue
C2	If behaviour does not improve a second verbal warning and an in-class response - moving seats or time outside the classroom. Final chance to alter behaviour.	
C1	Verbal warning given that the behaviour is unacceptable Chance to alter behaviour.	

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Around the School Behaviour Ladder

At Caldew School we expect students to behave responsibly and follow instructions from staff. Below is a chart which sets out the school's behaviour curriculum.

C6	Very serious incident - immediate removal from lessons and social time. Refocus or Suspension. Parents informed.	Examples Include: Swearing at staff, child on child abuse, bullying, fighting, assault, harassment.
C5+	Loss of free time for a number of days. Behaviour log Parents informed.	Examples Include: One-off serious incident, repeated incidents of defiance to staff, failure to follow consequence system, unsafe behaviours during social time.
C5	Behaviour log - Senior Leaders Detention (40 minute). Parents informed.	Examples Include: Sustained defiance, verbal aggression, threats to students, bullying.
C4	Behaviour log - Middle Leaders Detention (20 minutes) and parents will be informed.	Examples Include: Repeated poor behaviour, One-Off incidents such as squirting water, more than one student in a toilet cubicle, swearing on corridors.
C1	Verbal warning given and a chance to alter behaviour. Mobile phones, earbuds or headphones will be confiscated.	Examples of behaviours for a C1 Include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Running on the corridors Hanging around the toilets Not following instructions Shouting/screaming Pushing/playfighting Pushing in to the queue <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dropping litter Incorrect uniform Mobile phones, earbuds or headphones issue

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
