What are Achievement Logs given for?

 Caldew School Rewards 		
At Caldew School we understand the importance of rewarding and celebrating students. Below is a chart which sets out the school's Reward System.		
Daily	Classroom Achievement Log (1 Point) In every lesson you can earn an achievement log. This could be for having a good attitude to learning, quality work, excellent effort or improved progress.	Achievement points will be logged on Sims by your teacher.
Weekly	HOY Star of the Week (5 Points) Students with the highest number of achievement points during the week will achieve this reward.	A certificate will be given out in assembly
Weekly	Caldew Community Achievement Logs (2 Points) Extra curricular participation (Sport/P Arts/Student Council/Maths Challenge/Workshops/Good Attitude and behaviour on school trips.	Achievement points will be logged on Sims – please make sure you register for the different activities!
Half Termly	Achievement Certificates These are based on achievement points accrued Bronze - 75 Silver - 150 Gold - 300 Platinum - 600 1200+ Club.	A certificate will be given out in assembly each half term
Half Termly	Department Star of the Half Term - 1 Per Year Group (5 Points) Awarded for the highest number of achievements in a particular subject.	A certificate will be given out by the Head of Department.
Half Termly	Headteacher Star of the Half Term - 1 Per Year Group (5 Points) Nominated by the Head of Year.	Breakfast with the Headteacher and a text will be sent home.
Termly	Rewards Event The top 50 students in each year group are invited.	There are different events which can take place in and out of school.
Yearly	Caldew Annual Awards Ceremony Stars of the year nominated for work in subjects, highest number of achievements, outstanding contribution to Caldew Community.	Parents invited to an awards presentation ceremony.
